VOLUNTEER SEED COLLECTION

Each year volunteers, staff, partners, and Operation Fresh Start participants collect and process native plant seed from prairie, savanna, wetland, and woodland ecosystems. The seed is worth approximately \$600,000 and is used to restore over 170 acres of park lands.


CLEAN SWEEP HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DISPOSAL EVENT

This event is open to all Dane County residents and offers an opportunity for residents to safely dispose of hazardous waste, household chemicals and other items that pose potential environmental and safety risks. These items shouldn't be placed in curbside trash or recycling bins.

PLANT OF THE WEEK!

Prairie's are an important part of our Dane County Park Systems and to promote their beauty the Dane County Park's Newsletter will begin to promote a new prairie plant!

This newsletter's prairie plant is, **New England Aster,** or Symphyotrichum novae-angliae, blooms in fall, late August to early October. This plant ranges from 1 to 5 feet tall and has a beautiful purple flower. This flower provides nectar to our native pollinators like bumblebees and butterflies. This plant's seeds are also important for migratory birds.



